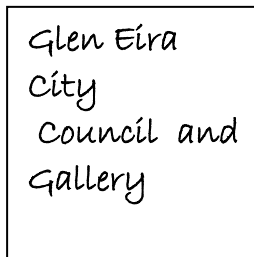

Join Peter Edgeley and prize-winning Botanical Artist Bev Lewis for a casual gathering at Peter's Studio off St Kilda Rd. The Studio Visit is a treat in itself to view a Bauhaus style building in the heart of Melbourne and the workspace of an architect-architectural Illustrator. This is our 2<sup>nd</sup> GEAS visit. Peter's Agenda is:

- \* photography or scanning of painting or drawing
- \* choosing a frame and mount for size and cropping
- \* selection of suitable paper for your process
- \* preparation of digital file in Photoshop
- \* choice of printer and archival ink/lightfast issues
- \* printing and matching paper profiles
- \* embossing stamp, credits, authentication & edition numbers

Bev's Agenda:

- \* scanner & printer contacts for archival level printing
- \* card and bookmark printing and costs; where I had them printed; source of cellophane sleeves for packaging
- \* the authentication certificate I provide to buyers for them to put on the back after they get the print framed
